# **Representative Matters**

Pacho Limited Partnership, et al. v. Eureka Energy Co., San Luis Obispo County Superior Court No. 19CV0158. Successfully represented a subsidiary of PG&E, as property owner, in complex dispute involving application of Civil Code section 717 to long-term lease of Wild Cherry Canyon, 2,400 acres of pristine coastline serving in part as buffer for Diablo Canyon Power Plant, largest power station and only operational nuclear plant in California. Judgment entered in favor of client following fourweek trial.
